SECTION – 1

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

INTRODUCTION

1.01 The tenderer in his own interest is advised to read very carefully these instructions, terms and conditions as incorporated in Section-I before filling this tender form. If he has any doubt as to the meaning of this specification of any portion thereof, he shall before submitting the tender may write/enquire about the same from the Superintending Engineer. T.A. to Chief Engineer (T&C), RVPN, New Building, Ajmer Road, Jaipur-302020, before the specified date of opening of tenders, in order that such doubt(s) may be removed. Submission of the tender shall be deemed to be conclusive proof of the fact that the tenderer has acquainted himself and is in agreement with all the instructions unless otherwise specifically indicated/commented by him in his tender offer.

1.02 **FILLING OF TENDERS:**

- a) Tenders shall be submitted in the form 'G' Schedule attached here with, filled up all the blanks in the tender and the schedules and the specifications.
- b) No alteration shall be made in the form of the tender or specifications or schedules. The tenderer must comply completely with the specification of this tender. Alternative proposal, if any, should be clearly stated in the covering letter.
- c) Tender should be filled in with ink or should be typed. The Tender filled in by pencil or otherwise shall not be considered.
- d) The tender and all accompanying documents shall be either in Hindi or English language and shall be signed by a responsible

and authorized person. The name, designation and authority of the signatory shall be stated in the tender.

- e) All additions, alterations and over writing in the tender must be clearly initialed by the signatory in the tender.
- f) The tenderer must quote the prices strictly in the manner as indicated in the specification, failing which tender is liable for rejection. The rates/prices shall be written in words as well as in figures, those must not contain any additions, alterations, over writings, cuttings or corrections or any other marking which may leave any room of doubt.
- g) The purchaser will not be responsible to accept any costs involved in the preparation and submission of tender.
- h) Any printed conditions of sale on the tender shall not be accepted by the purchaser, the tenderer shall incorporate his conditions of sale, if any, in the text of the tender itself.
- i) The tender shall be placed in double sealed or gum pasted cover/envelop which will super scribed astender against specification No. RVPN/CE(T&C)/TN-05/2009-10 due to open on date 23.03.2010.
- j) All tenders and accompanying documents shall be addressed to the T.A. to Chief Engineer (T&C), RVPN, New Prasaran Bhawan Building, Ajmer Road, Jaipur –302020.
- k) The tenderer must sign at the end of each page of the tender.
- l) Telegraphic quotations will not be considered unless immediately followed by confirmation with full relevant details and sufficient earnest money deposited before the opening date of the tender. The detailed tender should also have been posted/received before the due date of opening of the tender.

1.03 EARNEST MONEY

- a) Before submitting the offer, the tenderer shall deposit earnest money with the Sr. Accounts Officer (T&C) RVPN, New Building, Ajmer Road, Jaipur-302020. Amount of earnest money i.e. Rs. 14,000/- (Fourteen Thousand only) should be deposited in cash or by account payee demand draft in favour of Sr.A.O.(T&C, RVPN, Jaipur and shall be payable at Jaipur. No other mode of deposit of earnest money will be accepted.
- b) Any tender not accompanied by a copy of receipt for Earnest Money/crossed bank draft shall be rejected and the tender will not be opened.
- c) In case of unsuccessful tenderers, the Earnest money will be refunded as early as possible after finalization of the tender.
- d) The Government Undertaking/Corporations and companies are exempted from furnishing of earnest money deposit. However they have to furnish certificate/documentary evidence in support of their being Govt. Undertaking.
- e) Request for adjustments/proposal for acceptance of earnest money deposits, if any, already lying with the NIGAM in connection with some other tenders/orders shall not be entertained.
- f) No interest shall be payable on deposits such as earnest money, security deposits and Misc. deposits etc.
- g) The purchaser reserves the right to forfeit earnest money deposit or a part thereof in circumstance, which according to him indicate that the tenderer is not interested in accepting/executing any order placed under the specification.
- h) Firms registered with the respective wings/offices under the scheme for registration of firms/contractors on furnishing in original or photo stat copy duly attested by an officer of the company regarding registration with the name of item for which registered, shall be exempted from furnishing of earnest money

with the tender. Firms not registered for the material/works under tender enquiry, would not be entitled for exemption from earnest money deposit.

- i) Earnest money of successful tender will be refunded after satisfactory completion of supply/work and after expiry of Guarantee period subject to the satisfactory performance of the material supplied or work executed as the case may be.

1.04 RECEIPT AND OPENING OF TENDERS:

- a) Sealed/gum pasted covers/envelops, in which tenders are enclosed shall be delivered in the office of the Executive Engineer, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur, New Building, Ajmer Road, Jaipur-302020, upto 02:30 P.M. on Dt. 23.03.2010. Tenders shall not be accepted after the 02:30 P.M. and date so fixed and will be returned unopened to the tenderer. The tender will be opened in the office of the Executive Engineer, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur on Dt. 23.03.2010 at 03:00 P.M. in the presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives who may choose to be present.
- b) If the date fixed for opening of the tenders is declared public holiday, the tenders shall be received and opened on the date on which office reopen after such holiday on the timing as indicated above.

1.05 VALIDITY OF OFFERS:

Tenders shall be valid for a minimum period of **four months** from the date of opening of the tenders. Tenders mentioning shorter validity period than the specified, are likely to be ignored.

1.06 DELIVERY/COMPLETION PERIOD:

The work/supply should be completed within the stipulated delivery schedule as specified in the detailed order, failing which a penalty equivalent to 0.5% per week or part thereof limited to a

maximum of 10% will be imposed on the delayed work/supply. The period for which work/supply held up due to departmental reasons shall be excluded from the completion period.

1.07 GENERAL:

- a) Purchase of a copy of this specification by the tenderer is essential for the consideration of his tender. Only one tender will be accepted against each copy of the specification purchased. This specification is not transferable. The value of tender form once sold will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- b) The contractor shall treat the details of the specification and other tender documents as private and confidential and they shall not be reproduced without the written authorization of the NIGAM.
- c) The NIGAM does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender or any part of the tender and shall not assign any reason(s) for the rejection of any tender or a part thereof.
- d) The fact of submission of tender to the NIGAM shall be deemed to constitute an agreement between the tenderer and NIGAM whereby such tender shall remain open for acceptance by the NIGAM and tenderer shall not have option to withdraw his offer, impair or derogate the same. If the tenderer be notified during the period of validity of tender that his tender is accepted by the NIGAM, he shall be bound by the terms of agreement constituted by his tender and such acceptance thereof by the NIGAM, until format contract of the same tender has been executed between him and the NIGAM in replacement of such agreement.
- e) The successful tenderer shall have to execute the contract agreement for the proper fulfillment of the contract. This shall be done by him and the NIGAM shall be furnished such an executed stamped agreement free of charge.

1.08 PRICE CHANGE:

Any action on the part of the tenderer to revise the rates/price at his own interest after the opening of the tender may result in rejection of the tender and also debar him from submission of tenders to the NIGAM at least for one year.

1.09 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT:

The bidder should have sufficient experience in the same type of work/supply/manufacturing and he will have to submit completion certificate/experience certificate in respect of similar type of work/supply/manufacturing during last two years.

1.10 EMPLOYEES PROVIDENT FUND:

The contractor shall have to submit a certificate every month that he has an establishment covered under the Employee Provident Fund and miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 and he has a separate code No. with Provident Fund Commissioner and also that the Provident Fund Contribution in respect of all the employees employed by him along with employer's share of contribution etc. is being deposited with the Provident Authority and shall also submit certified photo copies of challans of deposits. In absence of above, the contractor shall be liable to deposit employees as well as Employer's contribution and other charges in respect of all employees engaged by him for said work with RVPNL along with details of all employees their names and amount of contributions as per RVPNL CPF service rules every month. In case of failure, RVPNL, shall be entitled to deduct 16% of the amount from his bills. The Form No. 2 & 6 (CPF & EPF) shall also have to be attached by the contractor along with his running/final bills.

1.11 INSPECTION, TESTING & CHECKING:

The finished products shall be subjected to inspection i.e. dimensional checking as per specifications, drawing & GTP in presence of purchaser's Inspecting officer. Galvanized test certificate shall be furnished to the inspecting officer for acceptance. If the material found acceptable under the tests carried out as tender specification, the purchaser's representative may seal the material for dispatch.

1.12. GUARANTEE :

The finished products should be guaranteed towards any kind of manufacturing defects or workmanship etc. for a period of six months from the date of completion of work.

1.13. RISK & COST :

If the contractor fails to execute the work or any part thereof within the specified completion time the Nigam shall be entitled at his option to cancel the contract if so to complete the work by other agencies at the risk and cost of the contractor.

1.14. SAFETY MEASURE :

The contractor shall follow a safe method of working so that there is no damage to Nigam's material and also no injury to any of his workers. The contractor shall be fully responsible for safety of his workers and RVPNL will not be responsible for any type of accident minor or fatal to any person at works site. Staff insurance charges shall be borne by the contractor.

1.15. CANCELLATION OF ORDER :

Order placed can be cancelled as per the decision of CE(T&C), RVPN, Jaipur in consultation with Sr. Accounts Officer or as applicable provisions from time to time.

1.16. SALES TAX, SERVICE TAX, LEVIES & DUTIES :

- a) In accordance with the scope of works, this is a labour contract of fabrication from the "FREE ISSUE" material, hence no sales tax will be leviable. However sales tax if levied shall be to the Contractor's account.
- b) Service Tax : The service tax (including cess on service tax), if, applicable shall be borne by the contractor.
- c) Work contract Tax: The work contract tax will be deducted at the applicable laws on the value of erection, testing & commissioning activities. Any liability arising on account of work contract tax will be to the contractor's account. Any statutory variation in the work contract tax will be to the contractor's account.
- d) Income Tax: If any income tax, surcharge on income tax or any other corporate tax is attracted under the law then the same shall be paid by the contractor as per Government rules/deducted from his bills/invoices at the prevailing rate and if such tax is not applicable, then the contractor can claim reimbursement of the same from the relevant competent authority. However necessary TDS certificate(s) shall be issued by Nigam's Paying Authority.

SECTION –II
GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Notwithstanding any thing contained to the contrary in the specification or tender or any subsequent exchange of correspondence, these general conditions of contract shall prevail and shall be binding upon the contractor and any change of variation expressed or impressed, whatsoever, made in the said general conditions shall not be valid for operation unless expressly sanctioned by the RVPN. The contractor shall be deemed to have fully informed himself and to have specific knowledge of the provisions of the General /Conditions of the contract herein.

2.01 **DEFINITION:**

In constructing these conditions of contract and specification the following words shall have the meaning herein assigned unless there is something in the subject matter of context inconsistent with such construction

(i) **PURCHASER:**

Shall mean Executive, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur and shall include his legal personal representatives, successors and assignees and any officer (s) of the RVPN performing the duties/function of the purchaser.

(ii) **CONTRACTOR/SUPPLIER:**

Shall mean tenderer whose tender has been accepted by the purchasing authority and shall include the tenderer's successors and assignees approved by the purchase officer.

(iii) CONSIGNEE:

The **Assistant Engineer-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur** will be the consignee for this work. He shall be maintain/upkeep all records pertaining to material account etc. pertaining to the work of galvanised structures.

(iv) ENGINEER:

Shall mean Executive Engineer/Assistant Engineer of the RVPN or other Engineer or Officer for the time being of from time to time duly authorized and appointed by the purchaser or by any competent authority to act as Engineer or Inspector for the purpose of the contract.

(v) PLANT WORK OR WORKS:

Shall mean and include the plant and material to be provided and work to be done by the contractor under the contract.

(vi) The 'Contract' shall mean the Contract established between the purchaser and the contractor/supplier and includes the instruction to the tenderers, General Conditions of contract, Specifications, Schedules, drawings, forms of tender, covering letters, schedule of prices, letter of intent, purchase order, power of attorney, other related documents etc.

(vii) The specification shall mean the specification annexed to these general conditions and the schedule thereto (if any) and also any other specifications mentioned in the contract of otherwise incorporate from time to time.

(viii) The month shall mean a period of 30 days and week means a period of SEVEN DAYS.

- (ix) The contract price shall mean the sum named in of calculated in accordance with the provisions of the contract/purchase order any amendment thereto.
- (x) Engineer In-charge of Works:
In-charge of work shall mean and include the Executive Engineer, Assistant Engineer, Junior Engineer or any other officer performing the duties of Engineer at the work site.
- (xi) Successful tenderer shall mean the tenderer whose tender has been accepted.
- (xii) The 'Site' shall mean place of places named in the contract and include where applicable the land buildings over/under/upon and in which the material is to be installed and the work is to be executed.
- (xiii) The 'Place of delivery' shall mean the place of delivery at which the contractor is responsible to deliver/handover the material/execute work at the contract prices as specified.

2.02 SUBLETING AND ASSIGNMENT:

The contractor shall not, save with the previous consent in writing of the purchaser, sublet. Transfer of assign the contract, or any part a thereof, interest therein or benefit or advantage whatsoever, provided never the less that any such permission granted to the contractor shall not relieve him from any obligation, duty or responsibility under the contract.

2.03 PRICES:

- (a)The quoted prices shall be inclusive of lifting of scrap material from the T&C stores at Jaipur and to supply/deliver the fabricated structures i.e. finished product to the workshop of A.E.N-I (M&F).

(b) The tenderers must quote prices per tonne for execution of work at the work site inclusive of labour charges, and all type of other charges if any.

(c) Unless otherwise specified the rates/prices quoted shall be firm in all respect and independent of any variation on account of any reason till completion of the work as per order.

2.04 SECURITY DEPOSIT:

(a) In order to secure/ assure the fulfillment of the contract, the successful tenderer(s) upon receipt of preliminary acceptance letter/detailed purchase order as the case may be, shall furnish within a period of 15 days a security deposit amount equivalent to 2% (Two percent) of the contract value in cash or by crossed Bank Draft or by way of Bank Guarantee from the scheduled Bank in the prescribed proforma to be obtained from the NIGAM on a Non judicial stamp paper of Rs.100.00 of Rajasthan State duly authenticated by a 1st Class Magistrate or Notary Public or directly confirmed by the issuing Banker. Such Bank Guarantee shall be valid up to a period of 3 months from the date of completion of works (e.g. upto the last day of the calendar month) and if required by the NIGAM, The validity of the Bank guarantee shall be further extended for such period as desired. The B.G. is to be furnished in whole Rupees. However, supplier, who are registered under category D or above vendor scheme of the Nigam, are exempted for furnishing of security deposit.

(b) Unless otherwise specifically required to be retained/forfeited by the NIGAM, the Security deposit shall be refunded on request of the supplier after three months on completion of the entire work to the satisfaction of the NIGAM.

- (c) If the supplier fails or neglect to observe or perform any of his obligation under the contract, it will be lawful for the NIGAM to forfeit either in whole or in part at his absolute discretion, the Security deposit in the form of B.G. furnished by the supplier.
- (d) No interest shall be payable on such deposits, bank charges or any other charges, if any, shall be to the supplier's account. If the supplier fails to provide the security within the period specified, such failure shall constitute a breach of the contract and the NIGAM shall be entitled to make other arrangements at the risk and expenses of the supplier and the earnest money deposited by the supplier shall stand forfeited to the NIGAM.
- (e) The successful tenderers who are registered with the Nigam shall be exempted from furnishing of security deposit for the specific item for which they are registered except in the case of orders placed by generating projects.

2.05 INSPECTION, TESTING & CHECKING:

The finished products shall be subjected to inspection i.e. dimensional checking as per specification, drawing & GTP in presence of purchaser's Inspecting officer. Galvanized test certificate shall be furnished to the inspecting officer for acceptance. If the material found acceptable under the tests carried out as per IS, the purchaser's representative may seal the material for dispatch.

2.06 VAT:

If the VAT will be applicable in this work, charges @ 4% may be levied F.O.R. at A.EN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur.

The State Government (Finance Deptt.) vide gazette notification No. F.12(63)FD/TAX/2005-27 dated 28.04.06 allowed concession in applicable rate of VAT w.e.f. 1.4.2006, for sale to or purchase by RVPN for exclusive use in the Generation. Transmission or Distribution of electric power to the extent to which the rate of tax exceeds 4% against necessary certificate.

RVPN is registered as dealer under CST/RST No. 1421/05490 and TIN 08032/05436. However, RVPN will issue concession form for which firm is required to finish following documents to this office:

- (i) Copies of invoices.
- (ii) Copies of receipted challans.

2.07 TERMS OF PAYMENTS:

- (i) Payment will be made by Accounts Officer (TCC-I), RVPN, Jaipur only after completion of all contractual formalities and acceptance of Contract Agreement which will be conveyed by the Superintending Engineer, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur.
- (ii) 90% (Ninety percent) payment of the value of material supplied to the Nigam shall be made against the bill(s) to be submitted in triplicate to the consignee who will verify the bill and send it to Accounts Officer (TCC-I), RVPN, Jaipur for releasing payment.
- (iii) The balance 10% payment shall be made after ascertaining satisfactory performance of the material in good condition in our stores subject to completion of contractual formalities incorporated in work order and after effecting recoveries of all dues from the firm/contractor as per work order.

2.08 QUANTITIES:

- (a) The quantities indicated in the accompanied Schedule-'G' are provisional and the purchaser reserves the right of revising the same at the time of placing the order.
- (b) The purchaser also reserves the right to split the quantities and to entrust the order for the supplies to one or more suppliers. The tenderer shall agree to supply part quantities ordered on him at the rates/prices mentioned in his tender and/ or accepted by the purchaser.

2.09 DELIVERY PERIOD:

- (i) The work/supply shall be completed within a period of 120 days from the date of handing over the black material. The period of delay due to departmental reasons shall not be counted as delay in delivery period.
- (ii) The time will be the essence of the contract and if the work/supply is not completed within the specified delivery period as above or within any period of extension, if granted, you will be liable to penalty @ 0.5% per week or part there of subject to maximum 10% of the value of the delayed work/supply of material.

2.10 CONTRACT AGREEMENT:

For the due fulfillment of the contract, the contractor shall execute an agreement, in triplicate, in the prescribed form (to be obtained from the purchaser) on non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs.200/- as per stamp duty applicable of Govt. of Rajasthan, Such agreement shall be executed and signed by the competent authority of the contractor on each page with seal thereof, The original copy is only to be executed on the stamp paper. The remaining two copies may be executed on simple paper. Such

complete agreement form along with the contract documents shall be required to be submitted to the purchaser within a period of 15 days from the receipt of order duly signed on the each page. The contract documents shall mean and include the following:

1. Contract agreement.
2. Work order and its annexure.
3. SECTION-I (Instructions to tenderers).
4. SECTION-II (General Conditions of Contract)
5. SECTION-III (Technical Specifications)

The charges in respect of execution of the contract agreement shall be borne by the supplier. A copy of contract agreement duly accepted by the purchaser shall be returned to the supplier for his reference.

2.11 CONSIGNEE:

The AEN-I (M&F) RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur shall be the Consignee of the material. He will receive the material, verify the bills of the supplier and shall maintain all material accounts and other relevant records pertaining to this contract.

2.12 FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE:

All correspondence pertaining to the contract in respect of any clarification required on the terms and conditions etc. should be addressed to the Executive Engineer, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur -302020.

2.13 DISPUTES:

- (i) All disputes, difference, questions, whatsoever arising between the RVPN and Contractor upon or in relation to or in connection with the contract shall be deemed to have arisen at JAIPUR (RAFASTHAN) only and no courts other than courts in Jaipur shall have jurisdiction to entertain the same.

- (ii) For settlement firm shall furnish in writing their representation indicating the details of disputes/grievances alongwith requisite settlement fee within a period of six months after receiving communication from CE (T&C) wing giving rise to cause of disputes/grievances.
- (iii) In case firm wishes to apply for review of decision of CE level/CMD level settlement Committee, then such request shall be entertained if it made with requisite fee within three months from the date of conveying such decision to the firm.

2.14 CANCELLATION OF ORDER

Order placed can be cancelled as per the decision of CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur in consultation with Sr. Accounts Officer or as applicable provisions from time to time.

2.15 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The acknowledgement of this work order must be conveyed within ten days from the date of receipt of order. In case no communication received within ten days it shall be deemed as received and accepted by you.

SECTION-III

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION FOR GALVANISATION OF STRUCTURE MATERIAL AT FIRMS GALVANISING PLANT.

SCOPE: This section covers technical specification for the work of Galvanisation of structure material at firms galvanising plant.

Fabricated members/structures will be arranged by the department from the stores of AEN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur for the work of fabrication Galvanisation of member/structure at firms galvanising plant. This work involving of transportation of fabricated members/structures from the stores of AEN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur to the firms galvanising plant. The departmental vehicles will be arranged for transportation but loading/unloading & stacking of material shall be carried out by the contractor/Firm.

Galvanisation of members/structure material shall be carried out by the firm. No machine & material except RVPNL vehicle will be provided by the RVPN involving following activities:

- (i) Lifting of Black fabricated members/structures from the store of AEN-I (M&F) RVPNL, Heerapura and unloading at firms galvanising plant.
- (ii) Lifting of galvanised members/structures from the firms plant and unloading & stacking in the store of AEN-I, (M&F) RVPNL, Heerapura, Jaipur.
- (iii) Vehicle for transportation of material will be provided by the RVPNL, but no machine material and labour will be provided for galvanisation lifting, unloading & stacking work.

TECHNICAL PARTICULARS

- (i) Sample/specimen of structure to be galvanised will be made available by the AEN-I(M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur and interested parties who so ever may visit during office hours on any working day in the office of AEN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur.
- (ii) The maximum length of the members to be galvanised will not be more than 6 mtrs.
- (iii) Standard to which galvanisation shall confirm IS:4759.
- (iv) Quality of zinc used for galvanisation as per IS 209.

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

INTRODUCTION

1.01 The tenderer in his own interest is advised to read very carefully these instructions, terms and conditions as incorporated in Section-I before filling this tender form. If he has any doubt as to the meaning of this specification of any portion thereof, he shall before submitting the tender may write/enquire about the same from the Superintending Engineer. T.A. to Chief Engineer (T&C), RVPN, New Building, Ajmer Road, Jaipur-302020, before the specified date of opening of tenders, in order that such doubt(s) may be removed. Submission of the tender shall be deemed to be conclusive proof of the fact that the tenderer has acquainted himself and is in agreement with all the instructions unless otherwise specifically indicated/commented by him in his tender offer.

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- c) Tender should be filled in with ink or should be typed. The Tender filled in by pencil or otherwise shall not be considered.

- d) The tender and all accompanying documents shall be either in Hindi or English language and shall be signed by a responsible and authorized person. The name, designation and authority of the signatory shall be stated in the tender.
- e) All additions, alterations and over writing in the tender must be clearly initialed by the signatory in the tender.
- f) The tenderer must quote the prices strictly in the manner as indicated in the specification, failing which tender is liable for rejection. The rates/prices shall be written in words as well as in figures, those must not contain any additions, alterations, over writings, cuttings or corrections or any other marking which may leave any room of doubt.

- l) Telegraphic quotations will not be considered unless immediately followed by confirmation with full relevant details and sufficient earnest money deposited before the opening date of the tender. The detailed tender should also have been posted/received before the due date of opening of the tender.

1.03 ARNEST MONEY

- a) Before submitting the offer, the tenderer shall deposit earnest money with the Sr. Accounts Officer (T&C) RVPN, New Building, Ajmer Road, Jaipur-302020. Amount of earnest money i.e. Rs. 8,000/- (Eight Thousand only) should be deposited in cash or by account payee demand draft in favour of Sr.A.O.(T&C, RVPN, Jaipur and shall be payable at Jaipur. No other mode of deposit of earnest money will be accepted.
- b) Any tender not accompanied by a copy of receipt for Earnest Money/crossed bank draft shall be rejected and the tender will not be opened.
- c) In case of unsuccessful tenderers, the Earnest money will be refunded as early as possible after finalization of the tender.
- d) The Government Undertaking/Corporations and companies are exempted from furnishing of earnest money deposit. However they have to furnish certificate/documentary evidence in support of their being Govt. Undertaking.
- e) Request for adjustments/proposal for acceptance of earnest money deposits, if any, already lying with the NIGAM in connection with some other tenders/orders shall not be entertained.

Tenders shall not be accepted after the 02:30 P.M. and date so fixed and will be returned unopened to the tenderer. The tender will be opened in the office of the Executive Engineer, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur on Dt. 23.03.2010 at 03:00 P.M. in the presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives who may choose to be present.
- b) If the date fixed for opening of the tenders is declared public holiday, the tenders shall be received and opened on the date on which office reopen after such holiday on the timing as indicated above.

1.05 VALIDITY OF OFFERS:

Tenders shall be valid for a minimum period of **four months** from the date of opening of the tenders. Tenders mentioning shorter validity period than the specified, are likely to be ignored.

1.06 DELIVERY/COMPLETION PERIOD:

The work/supply should be completed within the stipulated delivery schedule as specified in the detailed order, failing which

a penalty equivalent to 0.5% per week or part thereof limited to a maximum of 10% will be imposed on the delayed work/supply. The period for which work/supply held up due to departmental reasons shall be excluded from the completion period.

1.07 GENERAL:

- a) Purchase of a copy of this specification by the tenderer is essential for the consideration of his tender. Only one tender will be accepted against each copy of the specification purchased. This specification is not transferable. The value of tender form once sold will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- b) The contractor shall treat the details of the specification and other tender documents as private and confidential and they shall not be reproduced without the written authorization of the NIGAM.
- c) The NIGAM does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender or any part of the tender and shall not assign any reason(s) for the rejection of any tender or a part thereof.
- d) The fact of submission of tender to the NIGAM shall be deemed to constitute an agreement between the tenderer and NIGAM whereby such tender shall remain open for acceptance by the NIGAM and tenderer shall not have option to withdraw his offer, impair or derogate the same. If the tenderer be notified during the period of validity of tender that his tender is accepted by the NIGAM, he shall be bound by the terms of agreement constituted by his tender and such acceptance thereof by the NIGAM, until format contract of the same tender has been executed between him and the NIGAM in replacement of such agreement.
- e) The successful tenderer shall have to execute the contract agreement for the proper fulfillment of the contract. This shall be

done by him and the NIGAM shall be furnished such an executed stamped agreement free of charge.

1.08 PRICE CHANGE:

Any action on the part of the tenderer to revise the rates/price at his own interest after the opening of the tender may result in rejection of the tender and also debar him from submission of tenders to the NIGAM at least for one year.

1.09 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT:

The bidder should have sufficient experience in the same type of work/supply/manufacturing and he will have to submit completion certificate/experience certificate in respect of similar type of work/supply/manufacturing during last two years.

1.10 EMPLOYEES PROVIDENT FUND:

The contractor shall have to submit a certificate every month that he has an establishment covered under the Employee Provident Fund and miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 and he has a separate code No. with Provident Fund Commissioner and also that the Provident Fund Contribution in respect of all the employees employed by him along with employer's share of contribution etc. is being deposited with the Provident Authority and shall also submit certified photo copies of challans of deposits. In absence of above, the contractor shall be liable to deposit employees as well as Employer's contribution and other charges in respect of all employees engaged by him for said work with RVPNL along with details of all employees their names and amount of contributions as per RVPNL CPF service rules every month. In case of failure, RVPNL, shall be entitled to deduct 16% of the amount from his bills. The Form No. 2 & 6

(CPF & EPF) shall also have to be attached by the contractor along with his running/final bills.

1.11 INSPECTION, TESTING & CHECKING:

The finished products shall be subjected to inspection i.e. dimensional checking as per specifications, drawing & GTP in presence of purchaser's Inspecting officer. Galvanized test certificate shall be furnished to the inspecting officer for acceptance. If the material found acceptable under the tests carried out as tender specification, the purchaser's representative may seal the material for dispatch.

1.12. GUARANTEE :

The finished products should be guaranteed towards any kind of manufacturing defects or workmanship etc. for a period of six months from the date of completion of work.

1.13 RISK & COST :

If the contractor fails to execute the work or any part thereof within the specified completion time the Nigam shall be entitled at his option to cancel the contract if so to complete the work by other agencies at the risk and cost of the contractor.

1.14 SAFETY MEASURE :

The contractor shall follow a safe method of working so that there is no damage to Nigam's material and also no injury to any of his workers. The contractor shall be fully responsible for safety of his workers and RVPNL will not be responsible for any type of accident minor or fatal to any person at works site. Staff insurance charges shall be borne by the contractor.

1.15 CANCELLATION OF ORDER :

Order placed can be cancelled as per the decision of CE(T&C), RVPN, Jaipur in consultation with Sr. Accounts Officer or as applicable provisions from time to time.

1.16 SALES TAX, SERVICE TAX, LEVIES & DUTIES :

- a) In accordance with the scope of works, this is a labour contract of fabrication from the "FREE ISSUE" material, hence no sales tax will be leviable. However sales tax if levied shall be to the Contractor's account.
- b) Service Tax : The service tax (including cess on service tax), if, applicable shall be borne by the contractor.
- c) Work contract Tax: The work contract tax will be deducted at the applicable laws on the value of erection, testing & commissioning activities. Any liability arising on account of work contract tax will be to the contractor's account. Any statutory variation in the work contract tax will be to the contractor's account.
- d) Income Tax: If any income tax, surcharge on income tax or any other corporate tax is attracted under the law then the same shall be paid by the contractor as per Government rules/deducted from his bills/invoices at the prevailing rate and if such tax is not applicable, then the contractor can claim reimbursement of the same from the relevant competent authority. However necessary TDS certificate(s) shall be issued by Nigam's Paying Authority.

SECTION –II
GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Notwithstanding any thing contained to the contrary in the specification or tender or any subsequent exchange of correspondence, these general conditions of contract shall prevail and shall be binding upon the contractor and any change of variation expressed or impressed, whatsoever, made in the said general conditions shall not be valid for operation unless expressly sanctioned by the RVPN. The contractor shall be deemed to have fully informed himself and to have specific knowledge of the provisions of the General /Conditions of the contract herein.

2.01 **DEFINITION:**

In constructing these conditions of contract and specification the following words shall have the meaning herein assigned unless there is something in the subject matter of context inconsistent with such construction

(i) **PURCHASER:**

Shall mean Executive, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur and shall include his legal personal representatives, successors and assignees and any officer (s) of the RVPN performing the duties/function of the purchaser.

(ii) **CONTRACTOR/SUPPLIER:**

Shall mean tenderer whose tender has been accepted by the purchasing authority and shall include the tenderer's successors and assignees approved by the purchase officer.

(iii) CONSIGNEE:

The **Assistant Engineer-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur** will be the consignee for this work. He shall be maintain/upkeep all records pertaining to material account etc. pertaining to this work of fabrication of 132 KV/220KV G.S.S. structures.

(iv) ENGINEER:

Shall mean Executive Engineer/Assistant Engineer of the RVPN or other Engineer or Officer for the time being of from time to time duly authorized and appointed by the purchaser or by any competent authority to act as Engineer or Inspector for the purpose of the contract.

(v) PLANT WORK OR WORKS:

Shall mean and include the plant and material to be provided and work to be done by the contractor under the contract.

(vi) The 'Contract' shall mean the Contract established between the purchaser and the contractor/supplier and includes the instruction to the tenderers, General Conditions of contract, Specifications, Schedules, drawings, forms of tender, covering letters, schedule of prices, letter of intent, purchase order, power of attorney, other related documents etc.

(vii) The specification shall mean the specification annexed to these general conditions and the schedule thereto (if any) and also any other specifications mentioned in the contract of otherwise incorporate from time to time.

- (viii) The month shall mean a period of 30 days and week means a period of SEVEN DAYS.
- (ix) The contract price shall mean the sum named in of calculated in accordance with the provisions of the contract/purchase order any amendment thereto.
- (x) Engineer In-charge of Works:
In-charge of work shall mean and include the Executive Engineer, Assistant Engineer, Junior Engineer or any other officer performing the duties of Engineer at the work site.
- (xi) Successful tenderer shall mean the tenderer whose tender has been accepted.
- (xii) The 'Site' shall mean place of places named in the contract and include where applicable the land buildings over/under/upon and in which the material is to be installed and the work is to be executed.
- (xiii) The 'Place of delivery' shall mean the place of delivery at which the contractor is responsible to deliver/handover the material/execute work at the contract prices as specified.

2.02 SUBLETING AND ASSIGNMENT:

The contractor shall not, save with the previous consent in writing of the purchaser, sublet. Transfer of assign the contract, or any part a thereof, interest therein or benefit or advantage whatsoever, provided never the less that any such permission granted to the contractor shall not relieve him from any obligation, duty or responsibility under the contract.

2.03 PRICES:

- (a) The quoted prices shall be inclusive of lifting of scrap material from the T&C stores at Jaipur and to supply/deliver the

fabricated structures i.e. finished product to the workshop of A.E.N-I (M&F).

(b) The tenderers must quote prices per tonne for execution of work at the work site inclusive of labour charges, and all type of other charges if any.

(c) Unless otherwise specified the rates/prices quoted shall be firm in all respect and independent of any variation on account of any reason till completion of the work as per order.

2.04 SECURITY DEPOSIT:

(a) In order to secure/ assure the fulfillment of the contract, the successful tenderer(s) upon receipt of preliminary acceptance letter/detailed purchase order as the case may be, shall furnish within a period of 15 days a security deposit amount equivalent to 2% (Two percent) of the contract value in cash or by crossed Bank Draft or by way of Bank Guarantee from the scheduled Bank in the prescribed proforma to be obtained from the NIGAM on a Non judicial stamp paper of Rs.100.00 of Rajasthan State duly authenticated by a 1st Class Magistrate or Notary Public or directly confirmed by the issuing Banker. Such Bank Guarantee shall be valid up to a period of 3 months from the date of completion of works (e.g. upto the last day of the calendar month) and if required by the NIGAM, The validity of the Bank guarantee shall be further extended for such period as desired. The B.G. is to be furnished in whole Rupees. However, supplier, who are registered under category D or above vendor scheme of the Nigam, are exempted for furnishing of security deposit.

(b) Unless otherwise specifically required to be retained/forfeited by the NIGAM, the Security deposit shall be refunded on

request of the supplier after three months on completion of the entire work to the satisfaction of the NIGAM.

(c) If the supplier fails or neglect to observe or perform any of his obligation under the contract, it will be lawful for the NIGAM to forfeit either in whole or in part at his absolute discretion, the Security deposit in the form of B.G. furnished by the supplier.

(d) No interest shall be payable on such deposits, bank charges or any other charges, if any, shall be to the supplier's account. If the supplier fails to provide the security within the period specified, such failure shall constitute a breach of the contract and the NIGAM shall be entitled to make other arrangements at the risk and expenses of the supplier and the earnest money deposited by the supplier shall stand forfeited to the NIGAM.

(e) The successful tenderers who are registered with the Nigam shall be exempted from furnishing of security deposit for the specific item for which they are registered except in the case of orders placed by generating projects.

2.05 INSPECTION, TESTING & CHECKING:

2.06 VAT:

If the VAT will be applicable in this work, charges @ 4% may be levied F.O.R. at A.EN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur.

The State Government (Finance Deptt.) vide gazette notification No. F.12(63)FD/TAX/2005-27 dated 28.04.06 allowed concession in applicable rate of VAT w.e.f. 1.4.2006, for sale to or purchase by RVPN for exclusive use in the Generation. Transmission or Distribution of electric power to the extent to which the rate of tax exceeds 4% against necessary certificate.

RVPN is registered as dealer under CST/RST No. 1421/05490 and TIN 08032/05436. However, RVPN will issue concession form for which firm is required to finish following documents to this office:

- (i) Copies of invoices.
- (ii) Copies of receipted challans.

2.07 TERMS OF PAYMENTS:

- (i) Payment will be made by Accounts Officer (TCC-I), RVPN, Jaipur only after completion of all contractual formalities and acceptance of Contract Agreement which will be conveyed by the Superintending Engineer, T.A. to CE (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur.
- (ii) 90% (Ninety percent) payment of the value of material supplied to the Nigam shall be made against the bill(s) to be submitted in triplicate to the consignee who will verify the bill and send it to Accounts Officer (TCC-I), RVPN, Jaipur for releasing payment.
- (iv) The balance 10% payment shall be made after ascertaining satisfactory performance of the material in good condition in our stores subject to completion of contractual formalities incorporated in work order and after effecting

recoveries of all dues from the firm/contractor as per work order.

2.08 QUANTITIES:

1.14 DISPUTES:

- (i) All disputes, difference, questions, whatsoever arising between the RVPN and Contractor upon or in relation to or in connection

with the contract shall be deemed to have arisen at JAIPUR (RAFASTHAN) only and no courts other than courts in Jaipur shall have jurisdiction to entertain the same.

- (ii) For settlement firm shall furnish in writing their representation indicating the details of disputes/grievances alongwith requisite settlement fee within a period of six months after receiving communication from CE (T&C) wing giving rise to cause of disputes/grievances.
- (iii) In case firm wishes to apply for review of decision of CE level/CMD level settlement Committee, then such request shall be entertained if it made with requisite fee within three months from the date of conveying such decision to the firm.

SCOPE: This section covers technical specification for the work of fabrication of structure material at workshop of AEN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur.

Scrap tower material will be arranged by the department from the stores of ACOS (T&C), RVPN, Jaipur & AEN-I/II (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur for the work of fabrication of tower/structure material at workshop of AEN-I(M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur. This work involving of transportation of scrap material from the stores of ACOS (T&C), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur & AEN-II (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur to the workshop of AEN-(M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur to the workshop of AEN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur. The departmental vehicles will be arranged for transportation but loading/unloading of material shall be carried out by the contractor.

Fabrication of tower/structure material at workshop of AEN-I (M&F), RVPN, Heerapura, Jaipur shall be carried out as per given sample, specification & drawing. Machine & Material will be provided by the RVPN involving following activities:
