






**QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT OF BIDDER FOR SUPPLY OF  
315MVA AUTO POWER TRANSFORMERS**

- 1.1 Qualification of bidder will be based on meeting the minimum pass / fail criteria specified in Clause No.2.0 & 3.0 below regarding the bidders Technical Experience & Financial Position as demonstrated by the bidder's response in the corresponding bid schedules. The bidder shall submit audited financial report for last 5 years preceding the date of bid submission. The bidder shall also be required to furnish the information specified in other clauses in their bid.
- 1.2 The owner may access the capacity and capability of the bidder, to ascertain that the bidder have adequate equipment design, infrastructure, manufacturing facilities, procedures including quality control and capacity to execute the scope of work successfully.
- 1.3 RVPN reserves the right to waive minor deviations if they do not materially affect the capability of the bidder to perform the contract.

**2.0 Technical Criteria**

- 2.1 The bidder, should have designed, manufactured, type tested, supplied, installed and commissioned 400 kV or above class transformers of atleast 200 MVA capacity (or equivalent capacity in banks of 3 single phase units). Such type of 2 Nos. Transformers should have been in satisfactory operation for atleast two (2) years on the date of bid opening in India.

**OR**

The 400 kV or above class transformer manufacturer(s) who have established production line in India for these equipment(s) based on technological support of a parent company or collaborator for the respective equipment(s) can also be considered provided :

- i) Such manufacturer has designed, manufactured, type tested, supplied, installed and commissioned 220KV or above class transformers.
- ii) the parent company (Principals) or collaborator should have designed, manufactured, type tested, supplied & installed and commissioned 400kV or above class transformers of atleast 200 MVA (or equivalent capacity in banks of 3 single phase units). Such type of 2 Nos. Transformers should have been in satisfactory operation for atleast two (2) years on the date of bid opening.
- iii) The 400kV or above class transformer manufacturer(s) furnishes:
  - a) a legally enforceable undertaking (jointly with the parent company or collaborator) (as per the format Appendix-1(A)) to guarantee quality, timely supply, performance and warranty obligations as specified for the equipment(s); and
  - b) a confirmation letter from the parent company or collaborator alongwith the bid stating that parent company or collaborator shall furnish performance guarantee upto Contract Performance Guarantee Period for an amount of 10% of the contract value of such equipment(s). This performance guarantee shall be in addition to Contract Performance Guarantee to be submitted by the Bidder.

### 3.0 Financial Position

The bidder shall meet the following minimum criteria:

- (a) Minimum Average Annual Turnover #(MAAT) for best three financial years out of last five financial years should be **Rs. 60 Crores**.  
# Annual total income as incorporated in the profit and loss account.
- (b) Bidder shall have liquid assets (LA) or/and evidence of access to or availability of credit facilities of not less than **Rs.10 Crores**.

In case, bidder is a holding company, MAAT & LA referred to in clause 3.0 (a) & (b) above shall be that of holding company only (i.e. excluding its subsidiary / group companies). In case, bidder is a subsidiary of a holding company, MAAT & LA referred to in clause 3.0 (a) & (b) above shall be that of subsidiary company only (i.e. excluding its holding company).

4.0 To be qualified for award, bidders shall provide satisfactory evidence to the owner of their capability and adequacy of resources to carry out the contract effectively. Bids shall include the following information:-

- a) Copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration and principal place of business, written power of attorney of the signatory of the bid to commit the bidder.
- b) Total annual turnover of supply of materials and equipment of similar nature over the last 5 years.
- c) Reports on the financial standing of the bidder including profit and loss statements, balance sheets and auditors reports of the past 5 years and an estimated financial projection for the next two years.
- d) Evidence of access to lines of credit and availability of other financial resources.
- e) Performance as prime supplier for the materials and equipment of similar nature over the last 5 years and details of other works in hand and contractual commitments.
- f) Details in support to have adequate infrastructure and experienced qualified engineers and staff associated with design, procurement and progress monitoring work.
- g) Description of the plan for carrying out the works.
- h) The qualification and experience of key personnel proposed for carrying out the work of supervision of ETC
- i) Authority to seek reference from the Bidder's banks.
- j) Proposal of manufacturing methods and schedule in sufficient detail to demonstrate the adequacy of the bidder's proposals to meet the technical specification and the completion schedule.
- k) Information regarding bidders anticipated ownership change (if such a change is anticipated, the scope and effect thereof shall be defined) during the period from bid submission to two years after commercial operation defined as successful completion of commissioning and acceptance by owner.

- 4.1 The above stated requirements are a minimum and the owner reserves the right to request for any additional information. Nigam also reserves the right to reject the proposal of any bidder, if in the opinion of the owner the qualification details are incomplete or the bidder is found not qualified to satisfactorily perform the contract then his price bid (Part-II) shall not be opened.
- 4.2 Nigam also reserves the right to waive minor deviations if they do not materially affect the capability of the bidder to perform the contract.
- 4.3 Notwithstanding anything stated as above, the Nigam reserves the right to assess the bidder's capabilities and capacity in terms of concurrent project commitments, available and deployable resource etc. to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Nigam.
- 4.4 Nigam does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any of the bids and reserves the right to accept any bid or reject any or all bids without assigning any reasons thereof.

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
